


EDITAL

PhD **Hélia Gonçalves Pereira**, Rector and President of the Scientific Council of the Universidade Europeia, makes known that:

1. The Jury of the public examinations for the PhD in **Design**, requested by the candidate **Davide Maria Parrilli**, chaired by the PhD **Ana Luísa dos Santos Marques**, Auxiliary Professor at IADE – Faculdade de Design, Tecnologia e Comunicação at Universidade Europeia, appointed by delegation of competences on the 9th of February 2024, is composed of the following members:

The Viva Voce Exam will consist of an oral presentation by the candidate, summarizing the content of the Thesis entitled "**A Human-Centered Ethical Framework for Addressing Privacy Issues in Service Design**", and highlighting its objectives, the means used in its realization and the main contributions of the research carried out. The candidate's presentation must not exceed 20 minutes.
4. There will then take place a Jury hearing and subsequent defence of the Thesis. In the discussion of the thesis, the candidate will have the same amount of time used by the members of the Jury.
5. The oral presentation by the candidate, the discussion and the defence of the Thesis are held in **ENGLISH**.
6. Once the Viva Voce Exam is concluded, the Jury will meet for their appreciation, whose summary will be written in the respective minutes.
7. Members of the Jury are invited to wear the academic attire.
